### NCSAPPB Board Member and Treasurer David Turpin Honored with IC&RC Presidential Leadership Award

Phyllis Abel Gardner, IC&RC President, presented the Presidential Leadership Award to Mr. David Turpin, IC&RC Secretary, in recognition of his outstanding contributions to IC&RC and the prevention, substance abuse treatment, and recovery professions.

The CEO/President of Clinical Services of North Carolina, Inc., Turpin is a therapist, clinical supervisor, and administrator in the fields of substance abuse and mental health. He holds licenses as a Psychological Associate, a Licensed Clinical Addictions Specialist, and a Certified Clinical Supervisor. He serves as the North Carolina Program Consultant for the Southeast ATTC, a Senior CARF Surveyor, and a Clinical Instructor at North Carolina State University in Raleigh.

Turpin was so surprised when he was announced as the recipient of the award that he waited until the next day to respond: "Yesterday, I was so overwhelmed, honored, humbled that I couldn't say anything. When I first came back to IC&RC around 1994, I made two promises to the NC Board. One, I would represent North Carolina and the field. Second, I would serve as a delegate with honor, dignity, and respect. Yesterday's award affirmed for me that, over the 20 years, I kept those promises." ■



### 2014 NCSAPPB Election

The NCSAPPB election season is upon us! Below are important dates for you to know.

There are two (2) seats up for election this year. One seat represents the North Central Region. The second seat is an At-Large position which means that any eligible/fully-credentialed counselor may nominate him/herself to run for this seat independent of where he/she resides or works.

Here are the counties that are comprise the North Central Region: Stokes, Rockingham, Alamance, Caswell, Person, Granville, Vance, Warren, Forsyth, Guilford, Orange, Durham and Franklin Counties.

*Note:* In many years, only a handful of people have been nominated for any given seat on the Board. Please consider nominating someone who is eligible (must be certified or licensed and live in the county in which the seat is available in North Carolina) or consider running yourself! Individuals who meet eligibility requirements may nominate him/herself to run for a seat on the Board.

All nominees will be contacted by the Board office in advance of having their name placed on the official ballot.
