Substance Abuse Prevention Outcomes

The Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant (SAPTBG), The Safe and Drug Free Schools (SDFS) grant and the Strategic Prevention Framework-State Incentive Grant (SPF-SIG) are three of the primary FEDERAL grants implemented by the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Division of MH/DD/SAS, Community Policy Management Section. The federal governing agency, Center for Substance Abuse Prevention (CSAP) of SAMHSA requires the states receiving these grants to report back to the Federal Government on a set of core process and outcome measures, referred to as the National Outcome Measures (NOMS) on the progress of the consumers. The current data reporting system used by the state of North Carolina does not have the technologically appropriate standardized system and does not have the capacity to collect information from the multiple prevention providers across the state.

Therefore, the Office of Prevention in the Community Policy Management Section is proud to introduce a level of data collection that will enhance the mission to help communities to be more accountable. North Carolina has contracted with

KIT (Knowledge Based Information Technology) Solutions, LLC to create the North Carolina Prevention Outcomes Performance System (NC POPS) that monitors and measures process and impact performance outcomes and provides knowledge for improved decision-making. NC POPS services will enable the prevention field to integrate outcomes in their planning to demonstrate the impact of their services for consumers.

Training for prevention providers began in September, 2008, with continuous support for the providers and for LME Directors and staff. It is planned for the NC-POPS system to be fully operational for July 1, 2009.

There is great excitement and eager expectations about this system and how it greatly changes the capacity to provide aggregated information for policy and program decision-making. At last, real time decisions can be made to better serve communities in a more cost effective and accountable manner for prevention. The Foundation has since reached out to other mental health professional associations and other agencies to formulate a broad disaster mental health response network that can provide a coordinated and comprehensive response. Licensed Clinical Addictions Specialists (LCAS) are the newest addition to the DRN!
