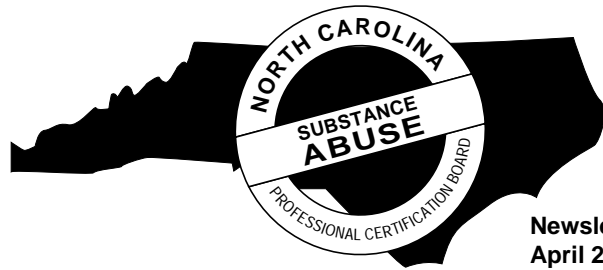

Why I Vote In Board Elections

Recently I was talking with a friend and colleague when the topic of certification board elections came up. She was very surprised that so few eligible voters responded in prior elections. Eighty-four percent (84%) of ballots were not returned last year, leaving only sixteen percent (16%) participation. My friend admitted to having lost last year's ballot, finding it only after the elections were over. Anyone could see how that might happen. Maybe if we all were to send our ballot back as soon as we receive it and fill it out. Or perhaps write the cut off date in our appointment book. Or maybe we can tie a string around our finger as a reminder to vote. Whatever it takes to help us remember to take part in this important process.

It is just impossible for me to believe so many of the professionals in this state are this unconcerned about who serves on the certification board. As substance abuse professionals we are directly affected by the actions of the board. We have been fortunate to have good, hard working people lead us over the past years, also we have had those who did not realize the demands on their time and once elected did not complete their term. A few years ago changes were made to open up the nomination process and to print each and every nominee on the official ballot. Some regions still have only one or two nominees and just a handful of votes mailed in. It is a small victory when so few individuals determine the outcome.

My hope is that those who have missed taking part in the NCSAPCB elections in the past will do so this year. We owe it to those who are willing to serve. It takes much dedication to effectively perform the duties of a representative. Let them know that we appreciate them by voting in the upcoming election.

Reprimand Issued to Charlene Lamb

On March 19, 2002, the North Carolina Substance Abuse Professional Certification Board issued a letter of reprimand to Charlene Lamb, CSAC # 1094, for failing to provide the supervision required by the State of North Carolina and this Board to those doing DWI assessments and those signing her signature to 508R forms as required by NC General Statute 122C-142.1 and 21 NCAC 68.0504. The degree of her responsibility and the severity of the sanction were mitigated by her serious illness during the time period in question.
