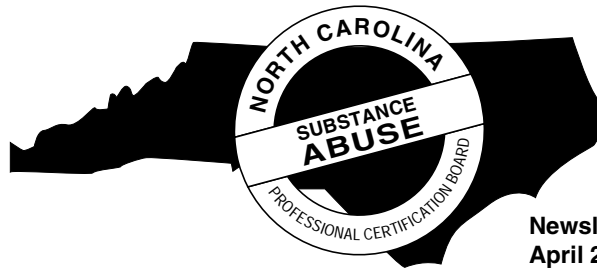

Board Elects New Officers for 2003–2005, Fills Board Vacancy

The North Carolina Substance Abuse Professional Certification Board, at its quarterly meeting in March, elected its new slate of officers for 2003–2005. Serving as Board officers will be:

These people will assume office at the end of the Board's annual meeting, which is held every year in August. Chairs of the Board's committees, who are appointed by the President, will be announced this fall when the new officers are installed.

In reflecting on the Board officers for the next two years, it is of interest to note that four of the Board's six officers are official representatives of Deemed Status organizations with the Board. Flay Lee, current president of the Board, commented that "this is an exciting day for the board. When Deemed Status groups were added to the Board several years ago, all of us hoped the representatives of those organizations would find their place of service on the Board. Its so exciting to see that has happened in such a significant way." Deemed Status organizations on the Board represent the advanced alcohol and drug credentials developed by the American Psychological Association, the Commission on Rehabilitation Counselor Certification, the International Nurses Society on Addictions, the National Association of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Counselors, the National Association of Social Workers and the National Board of Certified Counselors.

The Board also voted to fill the unexpired term of Helen Lee Keyes of Asheboro, who stepped down after six years as a Board member. The Board wishes to thank Helen for her years of service and everyone who recommended replacements for this position, as a number of highly qualified

persons were nominated. After careful consideration, the Board appointed Dr. Dewayne Book, medical director at Fellowship Hall in Greensboro, to fill Ms. Keyes' term. Dr. Book is a Certified Clinical Addictions Specialist with this Board, he is a medical doctor and is board certified in psychiatry as well as ASAM certified.

The Board wants to remind all its certified professionals that the election cycle for this year has begun. There will be several seats on the Board on the ballot, as three of the Board's members will be completing a second term and are ineligible to run for re-election.
