



## Flay Lee Elected To Full Term As IC&RC Vice President

Election Held at Fall IC&RC Meeting in San Diego

Flay Lee, long time member of the North Carolina Substance Abuse Professional Practice Board and former President of the Board, was elected to a full term as Vice President of the International Certification & Reciprocity Consortium/Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse. The meeting was held October 24–27, 2006 in San Diego, California. The election of officers was held on the final day of the meeting. Mr. Lee, who was elected last year to complete an unexpired term, was elected to a full two-year term this year, running unopposed for that office. Also elected at this meeting was new Secretary Sandra Del Sesto of Rhode Island. Ms. Del Sesto replaces outgoing Secretary John Barlow of Arkansas, who was ineligible to serve another term. Rounding out the leadership of IC&RC is President Jeff Wilbee of Canada and Treasurer Kristie Schmiege of Michigan.



When asked about his election, Mr. Lee responded, “It was indeed an honor to have been elected by acclamation to my first full term as Vice President of ICRC at our 2006 Fall Meeting in San Diego. I am where I am because I am blessed and believe in all possibilities. There are tough but exciting times ahead for ICRC. I believe that we have the leadership and support to continue beyond expectations and encourage excellence in our field. I want to assure all of our professionals in the State of North Carolina, the IC&RC Boards and others seeking licensure and certification that I will represent them well. ### **DWI Assessment Fee And DMV Evaluation Fee**

Last year the North Carolina General Assembly approved an increase in the amount of the fee for a DWI Assessment (commonly referred to as a “508” form). The fee was increased from \$50.00 to \$100.00. Please remember that the fee for a DMV Evaluation DID NOT increase at the same time. That fee remains at \$65.00.

### **US DOT SAP Providers**

Recently the United States Department of Transportation required that anyone who performs US DOT assessments must have completed a course of study on DOT guidelines and passed a national examination in addition to being credentialed with various groups (IC&RC member boards, NAADAC, EAPA). While many CSACs and CCASs have taken the exam offered through the IC&RC and its member boards, some have taken other national exams. If you would like your name to be noted, please furnish to the Board a copy of the certificate documenting your successful completion of the training and written exam of the other professional discipline.

### **Home Study Expanded To Include Initial Credentialing Hours**

For a number of years, the NCSAPPB has allowed up to 25% of renewal hours in home study if those courses had been pre-approved by the Board or by an organization granted Deemed Status with the Board. The Board is happy to announce that such preapproved home study may now be counted for up to 50 percent of the hours required for any initial credentialing or for the renewal of any credentialing.

### **Announcement**

Previously, the Board has required that signatures on the Letters of Reference for the Licensed Clinical Addictions Specialist be from persons who hold both a master’s degree and a CSAC or LCAS. In further review of the statute, it appears as though the persons who were grandparented into the LCAS with less than a master’s degree may also sign the Letters of Reference and that only the CSAC’s must also hold a master’s degree. The Board hopes this is of help to persons completing their application packets.
