NCAARF was formed circa 1974 to help provide training and networking opportunities for professionals throughout the state of North Carolina. The organization is a 501(c)3 agency. NCAARF has approximately 400 members at this time. Training events are held twice a year — in May and November.

NCAARF hosted its November training in Burlington, NC and recognized several substance abuse professionals for their dedication to the field during a luncheon. One of the awards given was the Walter Mitchell Memorial Award. This award is by given via nomination each year. It is named for Walter Mitchell who was one of the most outspoken advocates in this state for improving services and access to these services for individuals with substance abuse or addiction. Walter was tragically killed in an auto accident returning home from a meeting of substance abuse professionals. This year's honoree was L. Worth Bolton.

The Presidential Award is presented annually to an individual in the field that has distinguished themselves in some special way. This award was given to Anna Misenheimer, at the discretion of Randy Thornton, President of NCAARF. Leon Pernell graciously accepted the 2007 Presidential Award at this year's luncheon as he was unable to attend last year's banquet.

Three years ago, the board voted to provide financial assistance to any agency providing help to alcoholics and addicts. To qualify, the agency must be a non-profit and must provide a budget with a brief narrative stating financial need. Up to \$5,000 can be awarded to an agency, contingent on the current financial status of NCAARF. Becky

Yates, Executive Director of Caring Services in High Point, received a \$5,000 grant.

NCAARF's current board includes Randy Thornton-President; Lloyd Parsons-Vice President; Pam Story-Secretary/Treasurer; Gordon Rayle and Leon Pernell are Regional Vice Presidents. Brent Drum has been approached to fill the position as Western Regional Vice President. There is currently an opening for the North Central Regional Vice President.
