Voting For NCSAPCB Members

I have spent weeks mulling over alternative ways to approach the dicey issue of elections and voting for some members of our state Substance Abuse Professional Certification Board (NCSAPCB). By statute, some of the Board members have to be elected by the other certified and dedicated clinicians the boards oversees. The NCSAPCB has always been associated, in my mind, with the finest traditions in the human services field, particularly regarding personnel, reputation and, above all, the quality of service.

I trust you will excuse the liberty I take in doing this writing and making a clarion call, but the circumstances are such that we are bordering on a crisis vis-a-vis the participation of substance abuse professionals in electing those Board members. Here are the sobering statistics:

- In the 2000 election to the Board, of the 1,100 ballots mailed, only 143 ballots were returned (13%)
- In the 2001 election to the Board, of the 1,195 ballots mailed, only 207 ballots were returned (17%)

If optimism and goodwill would buy bread and gas and pay clinicians salaries, we should not have to ask for your help. Please do not leave it for the next person to do. Remember our best line of defense . . . our people power of today and tomorrow, under the auspices of the NCSAPCB.

I am reasonably assured that the responsibility we entrust to the NCSAPCB will be diligently fulfilled. Let's support our Board and meet OUR statutory obligations to vote for our Board members. Thanks for your help.
