



Deadline Extended for the Use of State Funded Y-Codes by Designated Non-Licensed Substance Abuse Professionals

In September of 2006, a State payment mechanism was made available for Local Management Entities (LMEs) to bill a new set of Y-Codes that could be utilized by designated non-licensed substance abuse professionals. These Y-Codes can be utilized for the provision of six identified services that are concurrently classified under one of the H-Codes.

This policy was originally scheduled to be phased out on June 30, 2007, however, due to several concerns about the lack of an available workforce of Licensed Clinical Addiction Specialists and Certified Clinical Supervisors, the North Carolina Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services has extended the deadline through the end of the 2007–2008 fiscal year. **This exception will not be extended beyond June 30, 2008, and affected professionals should plan to transition to the delivery of the new comprehensive substance abuse service definitions.**

The designated non-licensed substance abuse professionals who are eligible to be reimbursed through state funded Y-Codes through 6/30/08 are as follows:

- a) an individual who holds a Certified Substance Abuse Certification; or
- b) a registered nurse who is licensed to practice in the State of North Carolina by the North Carolina Board of Nursing who also has four years of full-time accumulated experience serving substance abuse clients; or
- c) graduate of a college or university with a Masters degree in a human service field and has one year of full-time, post-graduate degree accumulated supervised experience in alcoholism and drug abuse counseling; or
- d) a graduate of a college or university with a bachelor's degree in a human service field and has two years of full-time, post-bachelor's degree accumulated experience in alcoholism and drug abuse counseling; or
- e) a graduate of a college or university with a bachelor's degree in a field other than human services and has four years of full-time, post-bachelor's degree accumulated experience in alcoholism and drug abuse counseling.

The above individuals are required to be registered or credentialed with the NC Substance Abuse Professional Practice Board.

This option applies only to IPRS substance abuse target populations receiving enhanced benefit services. For providers who have access to a LCAS or CCS professional, these providers are required to continue to utilize the current H-Codes. The same IPRS edits, audits and rates will be in place for these Y-Codes as are currently in use with the comparable H-Codes.

Amendment To Calendar For Board Scholarship Requests Submission
