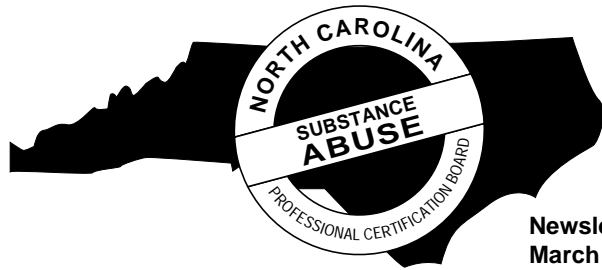

This position is responsible for planning, coordinating, implementing and evaluation of Halifax System of Care initiative including a staff of support individual(s), a data analyst and some contracted service providers.
