Jim Scarborough Announces Resignation From The NCSAPPB

Board's Executive Director Accepts Position in Washington, DC

Jim Scarborough, Executive Director of the NC-SAPPB since 1991, has accepted the new position of Director of Research and Special Projects at the State Associations of Addiction Services (SAAS) in Washington, DC, and will begin his new work on March 1. SAAS is the only national organization of state alcohol and drug abuse treatment and prevention provider associations. Through its member associations, SAAS has a direct link to the thousands of prevention and treatment programs that are the core of the publicly-supported substance abuse system. Since its founding in 1987, SAAS has been a leading



advocate for addiction prevention and treatment providers. SAAS and its member state associations work together to increase federal and state funding, expand services and improve the quality of treatment, prevention, training and research.

The mission of SAAS is to ensure the availability and accessibility of quality alcohol and other drug treatment, prevention, education and related services throughout the country. SAAS serves as an information broker and advocate, linking state associations with national developments such as evidence-based practices and providing input to federal organizations on the needs of community-based service providers and their clients.

Since 1996, working in partnership with the Legal Action Center and other advocacy organizations, SAAS has helped to secure federal funding increases of over one billion dollars for addiction treatment, prevention and education services and for research. Recognizing these and related efforts, the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation awarded SAAS a major grant to assist in establishing a national office in Washington and building provider associations in all states. North Carolina has long been a member of SAAS through its state chapter, the North Carolina Association for Behavioral Health Care.

Jim's major responsibility will be the development and management of applied research and projects that advance the mission of SAAS and take advantage of SAAS' unique access to the treatment and prevention field through our member state provider associations. SAAS has been successful in attracting government and foundation support for such projects and should have more opportunities. "I am very pleased that someone who knows providers and understands the role of state associations will be joining SAAS and I look forward to introducing Jim at the Spring Membership Meeting," said Howard Shapiro, Executive Director of SAAS.

Notice Of Reprimand To Harold J. Lilly

The Board hereby reprimands Harold G. Lilly for his repeated, fraudulent statements and misrepresentations that he obtained an undergraduate degree from the University of North Carolina at Pembroke. These misrepresentations are contained in his applications to the Board and to others who read his resume representing that he obtained an undergraduate degree from a branch of the University of North Carolina, a highly respected institution of higher learning.

He has held himself out as a substance abuse professional with an exceptionally high educational status, a doctorate degree, from an institution, Pacific Western University. At the time he attended this school, it accepted persons into its doctorate program who had not attained a master's degree or even an undergraduate degree prerequisite to a doctoral program. At that time, the University was "authorized" and later "approved" by the State of California. Not only was this process unusual but the fact that the status of Pacific Western University, at the time of his matriculation in 1994, was that of an institution not fully accredited by the U.S. Department of Education or other widely recognized educational accreditation authority, is the proper subject of evaluation by the public as to the weight of his title and educational credential.

Finally when this matter was made the subject of an inquiry by the Board, Respondent Lilly provided responses such that he carefully avoided ownership of his misdeeds, thus failing to demonstrate remorse by failing to take responsibility for his actions and adding to the basis for this action by the Board.

In taking this action, he is charged to heed this REPRIMAND, that it will be remembered by him, that it will be beneficial to him and that he will never again allow himself to depart from adherence to the high ethical standards of the substance abuse professional.

The board knows that he leaves us on solid footing to continue the work at hand. The knowledge he possesses from his diligence in treating the position as not just a job, rather a calling, made us feel very secure. He has been as close as a phone conversation or email with an answer to any possible question."

"I leave North Carolina after over 30 years with a mixture of excitement and sadness," Jim said. "I am extremely excited about this new position and look forward to the challenges it will bring. Last year and in many years, only one person has been nominated by the certified and licensed professionals for any given seat on the board. Please consider nominating someone who is eligible (must be certified or licensed and live in North Carolina) or consider running yourself! Individuals who meet eligibility requirements may nominate him/herself to run for a seat on the board. Eleven certified/licensed professionals are chosen by ballot by the certified/licensed professionals with the board.

North Carolina Department Of Health And Human Services Initiates Statewide Problem Gambling Services

The North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) is responsible for the development and implementation of a statewide problem gambling services program. Legislation creating the North Carolina State Lottery in August 2005 requires a transfer of \$1 million annually to DHHS for the support of problem gambling prevention and education, outreach and treatment programs. DHHS has delegated the administration of the Problem Gambling Program to the Division of MH/DD/SAS.

The North Carolina Problem Gambling Helpline (1-877-718-5543) has been in operation by the Division since March 2006 and under contract by Bensinger, Dupont and Associates since October 2006. The Helpline provides a toll-free statewide problem gambling helpline available 24/7 with options for Spanish as well as English. The helpline will link people wanting and needing services to available resources.

The Division will be developing a registry made up of licensed professionals. Toward this end, the Division is eager to provide broad-based training for licensed professionals with an interest in problem gambling treatment. This training is being offered as a foundation for the development of a North Carolina Problem Gambling Program (NCPGP) Registry made up of licensed professionals who will be authorized under the program to provide treatment services. Regional training will be offered through participating AHECs beginning in March 2007. Registration will be \$25.00 for the twoday training and participants will receive 15 hours credit for attending both days. Participation in this training does not assure that a provider will be selected for the NCPGP Registry. This training will be accepted by the NCSAPPB toward initial credentialing as a CSAC, CCJP, LCAS or CSAPC and for renewal of those credentials as well.

Applications Without Payments

Recently the board has received a number of applications for certification, licensure and training approval without payment or with notations that payment will follow. This makes it difficult for staff to maintain complete records on payments received by the board. Therefore, beginning on April 1, 2007, any application received without payment will be returned to the applicant or provider.

Additionally, it has long been the policy of the board not to accept applications or training approval requests by fax. Please note that, unless otherwise notified, applications received by fax will not be processed but will be returned to the applicant or provider.

Announcement

Previously, the Board has required that signatures on the Letters of Reference for the Licensed Clinical Addictions Specialist be from persons who hold both a master's degree and a CSAC or LCAS. In further review of the statute, it appears as though the persons who were grandparented into the LCAS with less than a master's degree may also sign the Letters of Reference and that only the CSAC's must also hold a master's degree. The Board hopes this is of help to persons completing their application packets.

Home Study Expanded To Include Initial Credentialing Hours

For a number of years, the NCSAPPB has allowed up to 25% of renewal hours in home study if those courses had been preapproved by the Board or by an organization granted Deemed Status with the Board. The Board is happy to announce that such preapproved home study may now be counted for up to 50 percent of the hours required for any initial credentialing or for the renewal of any credentialing.

If you have questions about whether or not a course has been preapproved, please contact the Board office for more details.

US DOT SAP Providers

Recently the United States Department of Transportation required that anyone who performs US DOT assessments must have completed a course of study on DOT guidelines and passed a national examination in addition to being credentialed with various groups (IC&RC member boards, NAADAC, EAPA). While many CSACs and CCASs have taken the exam offered through the IC&RC and its member boards, some have taken other national exams. If you would like your name to be noted, please furnish to the Board a copy of the certificate documenting your successful completion of the training and written exam of the other professional discipline.

Procedures For Filing An Ethical Complaint

For any individual who believes an ethical violation has occurred, the following steps must be taken:

Initiation: Any individual with personal knowledge that any person has violated the Code of Ethical Conduct, any other rules of the North Carolina Substance Abuse Professional Practice Board, or the statute authorizing the work of this Board (GS 90, Article 5C) may file a complaint against the substance abuse professional by submitting a written complaint on proper Board forms addressed to the Chair of the Ethics Committee.

Form: The complaint, stating the nature of the alleged offense and signed by the complainant (the person who makes the complaint), shall include:

- 1. the name, address, and telephone number of the complainant;
- 2. the name, address, and telephone number of the person against whom the complaint is made (respondent);
- 3. a statement of the facts which clearly and accurately describes the allegations against the person.

Investigation: The complaint shall be investigated as set out in the North Carolina Administrative Code.
