



General Assembly Enacts Legislation Amending Credentialing Process

On July 28, 2008, the General Assembly of North Carolina enacted Senate Bill 2117, *Amend Substance Abuse Professionals Act*, without a dissenting vote in either chamber. This legislation promotes workforce development by streamlining the application process and updates terminology in keeping with other licensing boards.

The application process has been simplified with the elimination of the oral examination. The elimination of the oral examination saves applicants \$100 in initial credentialing fees and streamlines the application process. As a consequence, new CSAC and LCAS written exams have been compiled. Competencies that used to be tested via

LCAS's Participate In First Commitment Waiver Study

The North Carolina Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services initiated a second phase of its First Commitment Waiver study in June. This study is occurring at new pilot sites and will focus on how Licensed Clinical Addictions Specialists as well as Licensed Clinical Social Workers review first commitment cases. Traditionally, physicians and psychologists have provided this service.

The Board office received a positive response to its request for LCAS volunteers to participate in the study. The LCAS's who are representing the Board are Blair Clark, Sandra Layton, Sharon Sigmon, Bill Vaughn, Kim Hutchinson and Pamela Moye. A three-day training was sponsored by the Division of MH/DD/SAS in late June. All six participants were required to take an examination at the conclusion of the training. Upon successful completion of the exam, these LCAS's were credentialed to perform the evaluations. Blair Clark, Sandra Layton, Sharon Sigmon, Bill Vaughn, Kim Hutchinson and Pamela Moye are now actively participating in the study, which will conclude on March 31, 2009.

The North Carolina Substance Abuse Professional Practice Board wishes to thank Blair Clark, Sandra Layton, Sharon Sigmon, Bill Vaughn, Kim Hutchinson and Pamela Moye for their participation in this study. Their commitment to the profession is evident and could result in the expansion of resources to consumers in their local crisis management continuum. The Board office will share the study's findings and recommendation at the conclusion of the study. Be sure to stay tuned.

the Case Presentation Method (CPM), commonly known as the oral exam, are now being tested on the newly-compiled written examinations. All applicants who have not yet been awarded a CSAC or LCAS credential must take and pass this written examination to meet the International Certification and Reciprocity Consortium's (IC&RC) standards for credentialing. Applicants applying for the LCAS via Criteria C will be required to successfully complete the written examination as well.

Applicants will continue to be scheduled to take the written examination upon obtaining registration status with the Board and after completion of the 300 Hour Supervised Practicum. Although one might take and pass the written examination, one must meet all credentialing standards (work experience and education/training hours) before being granted the credential.

The CSAC and LCAS study guides have been updated to reflect the composition and competencies tested on the examinations. The CSAC study guide is available for \$50 while the LCAS study guide costs \$29. Please contact the Board office to place an order.

Another major change enacted by this legislation is the elimination of the required 2,000 hours of post-master's degree work experience for a Criteria B applicant. Since these counselors have already completed 6,000 hours of work experience in order to obtain the CSAC credential, documentation of an additional 2,000 hours is unnecessary. This will streamline the LCAS application process.

Finally, the legislation updates terminology in keeping with terminology used throughout other health and human services professions. A "clinical addictions specialist intern" will now be referred to as a "provisional licensed clinical addictions specialist". It is the Board's desire that the amended terminology will ultimately result in LCAS-Provisionals being eligible to bill Medicaid for certain services.

The Board wishes to thank Senator Martin Nesbitt (D-Buncombe) and Representative Martha Alexander (D-Mecklenburg) for sponsoring the Bill that made these changes. Their legislative skill and ability to advocate for this legislation in terms understandable to all legislators made our work so much easier.

The Board is also indebted to and deeply appreciative of Ms. Flo Stein, Chief of Community Policy Management of the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Services, for the guidance and support she and her staff gave this legislation.
