



New NCSAPPB Rule Changes Go Into Effect

By now many professionals have heard all kinds of stories circulating about the new rules affecting licensed and certified professionals and those interested in becoming registered for the credentialing process. Please take time to read the following information to clarify the changes. Substance Abuse professionals should also take time to read through the all of the administrative rules available on the website.

Two of the changes with the greatest impact on the Board would be the new registration requirements (21 NCAC 68 .0216) and the new credentialing and renewal requirements (21 NCAC 68 .0205).

How have they changed? Applicants with certain criminal histories are now able to become registered with the NCSAPPB. This modification al-

lows interested applicants to enter the substance abuse field and become Registered Status in order to begin earning hours toward certification. These persons are still subject to the wait periods described in .0216 when trying to receive their full certification or license.

What is up with the new smoking cessation requirement? The Board of office has received many calls about the new education requirements for credentialing and renewal. The change states that for credentialing there is a required 6 hours of HIV/AIDS/Blood-borne Pathogens, 6 hours of Ethics, and 6 hours of EITHER: (i) Nicotine Dependence; (ii) Psychopathology; (iii) Evidence-Based Treatment Approaches; (iv) Substance Abuse Issues In Older Adults; OR (v) Substance Abuse Issues Affecting Veterans. These final six hours can also be ob-

tained in combination. You have many different options as opposed to simply being required to take courses in "smoking cessation." **Also please note that for renewals these required hours drop to three hours for HIV/AIDS, ethics, and the additional options listed above.**
