



## 2010 Annual Meeting of the Profession Training Event

Anytime the NCSAPPB Board can interact with persons who hold an addictions credential is an exciting event! December 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>, 2010 was the largest gathering to date with 272 professionals participating in two days of training. The Board couldn't have provided this training without the unselfish and dedicated services of addiction professionals that provided training at the event free of charge.

On Wednesday, December 8<sup>th</sup>, "Smoking Cessation Services to SA Clients" was presented by Lynn Inman while Carlene Wood taught the "Substance Abuse and Services to Offenders" track. "Effective Substance Abuse Group Services" was a topic presented by Jessica Holton. Connie Renz, Bill Bronson, Tanya Roberts, Jennifer Hardee and Rob Young collaborated and presented a track on "Effective Substance Abuse Group Services" on Thursday, December 9<sup>th</sup>.

It was my privilege to be a part of this training cadre to present "Clinical Supervision" on December 8<sup>th</sup> and "SA, PTSD & Returning OEF/OIF Vets" on the 9<sup>th</sup>. I will tell you that training your fellow addiction professionals is the most challenging, yet rewarding experiences one can have! To stand in that arena and see so many fellow professionals, many who come with so much experience, is always an opportunity to learn as well as to teach. Those of you who attended were asked to provide feedback on distributed surveys and evaluations. This feedback will assist the Board with their planning of this year's event and future Board trainings.

When the Board first started its discussions that resulted in this event, our desire was to provide quality training to bring as many of our professionals together in hopes that this annual training event would continue to grow in quality and numbers. Additionally, the Board hoped that those who attended would begin to gain a sense of the shared history of our profession at a time when the demand to demonstrate that providing services to those persons and their families struggling with addiction issues requires very specific knowledge, skills and attitudes seems ever-pressing. The "winds of change" at the state and national level indicate that we will be challenged to continue to provide these services in an increasingly difficult clinical and administrative environment. Fortunately, addiction professionals know and understand adversity and the stigma associated with working with persons that many would prefer to write off as "bad behavior."

The growth and development of professionals in our field is encouraging, but there is much yet to be done to ensure that we go forward with the integrity and professionalism that is required. We must continue to attract new, young professionals to our ranks who are mentored and encouraged to stay in the field as we move forward. The Board is always cognizant of the level of participation from its membership when we hold the Board's annual elections as well as other Board processes, such as rule revisions and requests for Board scholarships, just to name a few of the instances in which responses are solicited from the Board office. This provides the Board with a good measure of how much the field is connected to being a part of the ongoing process of growth and development. We all stand on the shoulders of those who fought the good fight to keep addiction services available to those persons and their families seeking services at a time when few services were available and many languished in jails, institutions or died. Those early professionals served at a time of low compensation, lack of professional respect and few resources. Many served because of their own life experiences and many because of their "12th Step" commitment.

We are fast approaching 2,200+ credentialed persons in the addiction profession in North Carolina and the Board is aware that many of you are working as hard as you can to stabilize the services needed to serve the conservative estimate of 600,635 in our state
